About Moravian stars

Moravian stars originate in the Czech republic as far back as the 1800's. They are displayed as a symbol of the star of Bethlehem over the Advent and Christmas period.

What will I make in this workshop?

A Moravian star requires 12 individual pieces. To ensure completion in the time allowed, the pieces are pre-cut to allow students to concentrate on foiling, tinning and assembly.

Each piece will have been cut and the edges ground in readiness for the workshop and will be available in various colours.

You will prepare and assemble the pieces and by the end of the workshop you will have a completed star to take home with you.

What's included in the workshop?

- Select from an array of pre-cut shapes in beautiful colours
- Edge, clean and foil individual pieces
- Use a hot soldering iron for tinning and assembly
- Use flux to 'tin' the edges of each piece
- Assemble your 3d star
- Add a hanger
- Clean and polish your finished star
- Tea, coffee and cakes/biscuits throughout the day
(we are a 5 star food hygiene rated catering venue too!)
