## What is glass fusing?

Glass fusing is a process where glass pieces and decorative elements fused together at high temperatures in a kiln. Depending on the process you choose you can make many different projects from light catchers to lanterns, jewellery to tea lights.

It's always a good idea to browse our Facebook page and website to find inspiration for the things you would like to make on your workshop.

## What's included in a half day workshop?

- Learn to cut glass
- Design several pieces (depending on size)
- Use a variety of glass fusing techniques to create your projects
- 2 firings in the glass kiln

   (typically your projects are fused flat to 'stick' all the elements together. A second firing shapes your project into a mould.
   Pieces can be collected or posted for a small P&P fee
- Tea, coffee and biscuits throughout the day (we are a 5 star food hygiene rated catering venue too!)

## What will I make in half a day?

This depends on the size of your projects(s) and the speed at which you work.

Most people will create 2 pieces on a half day workshop. If you decide on a lantern it will take you the whole workshop to design and create the four panels.

Ideally, arrive at the workshop with your ideas ready to go. That way you can spend your time making glass rather than thinking about it.
